# 

Without support, and at least 6 HCP, bid a higher 4 + card suit if possible

• At the 1 level you show 6+ points

• At the 2 level you show 10+ points (and an unbalanced hand) Otherwise bid No Trump

## **Definition of a Balanced Hand**

A balanced hand has no voids, no singletons, and at the most one doubleton

#### **Responder's Limit NT Bids**
